## Platts, Alonza Charles

**Rank:** Lieutenant

**Army Number:** 4849817

**Unit:** 1st Bn

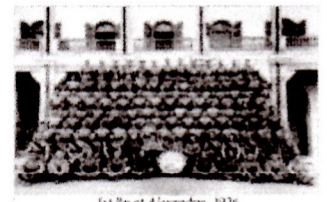
**Biography:** Joined Regiment 1918 and went with 1st Bn to India, 1924. Served in Egypt, and again later in India. Promoted C.Q.M.S. 4.4.1926. Transferred to Home Establishment 1931. Served four years with the 5th Bn, then rejoined the 2nd Bn. Platts had been Warrant Officer Class II on 5.6.1932, and in 1939 was serving as RQMS at the Depot. Received Lieutenant's Commission into Young Soldier's Bn 16.7.1941, where he served as Quartermaster. He was invalided out due to poor health on 27.6.1942. He died 26.4.1943, aged 42. He is buried at Coalville (Hugglescote) Cemetery, Leicestershire.
